

Digital Transformation of Records

Central Projects Division

The Centralized Projects Repository is crucial for any organization, and digitizing its records is essential for ensuring data integrity and accessibility. The Digitalization and CPD teams collaborated to successfully digitize over 100,000 records of ongoing projects. This initiative, led by the Digitalization and CPD teams was launched on May 22, 2024.

The Go-Live session was attended by Mr. Faisal Amir, CIO; Saiyed Shahab Ahmed, Acting Manager Digitalization; Mr. Umer Dilshad, Projects Lead and other senior leaders. At the occasion, the senior leadership emphasized the significance of the project in PARCO's digital transformation journey. Migrating project records to a digital platform improves accessibility, streamlines operations and enhances collaboration among teams.



Corporate Social Responsibility Department

In line with PARCO's strategic objective of Digitalization, the CSR and Digitalization teams successfully launched the CSR Department's record digitalization project on June 24, 2024. This initiative represents a key step towards a more streamlined and efficient operational model, leveraging advanced technology to digitally archive and manage our CSR projects. By digitalizing these records, we enhance accessibility and transparency, while reinforcing our commitment to sustainability and corporate responsibility.



Electronic MOC

On June 14, 2024, the IT Division celebrated the successful Go-Live of its latest landmark project, "Electronic Management of Change for Pipeline". It was followed by the Go-Live of "Electronic Management of Change for MCR" on June 27, 2024. The Digitalization Department, in collaboration with the Pipeline Division and MCR - ESD and TSD Departments, developed these systems.

The Electronic Management of Change applications transform traditional paper-based workflows into transparent digital processes. These applications enable users to raise change requests, track the approval process, and finalize changes efficiently. This digital shift not only enhances workflow transparency and efficiency, but also supports sustainability efforts by reducing paper usage.

Dashboard

SAC Analytics Cloud Management Go-Live

The implementation of the SAC (SAP Analytics Cloud) dashboard for higher management has successfully gone live, offering enhanced visibility into key organizational KPIs. This strategic tool empowers management with a comprehensive overview of the company's performance, enabling faster and more informed business decisions.

Key benefits of the SAC dashboard include:

- Enhanced KPI Visibility: The dashboard provides insights across various domains, including Finance, Sales, and
 Operations. It specifically focuses on MCR, PPGL, and PAPCO, which allows for a holistic understanding of
 performance.
- **Real-Time Data Integration:** By integrating with existing systems, the SAC dashboard facilitates real-time data analysis and report generation, ensuring that management has access to the most current information.
- Customizable Reporting: Management can tailor reports to meet their specific needs, allowing for deeper insights and a more focused approach to decision-making.
- Faster Decision-Making: With a holistic view of the company's performance and strategic metrics, the SAC dashboard accelerates decision-making processes, empowering leaders to act swiftly and effectively.

Additionally, hands-on training was provided to key users, ensuring that they can fully leverage the capabilities of the SAC dashboard for optimal performance and strategic planning. This implementation marks a significant milestone in enhancing our analytical capabilities and supports our commitment to data-driven decision-making.

Vehicle Reservation System

On April 4, 2024, the Digitalization team proudly launched the Vehicle Reservation System (VRS) Dashboard, a key tool designed to empower the Administration team in making data-driven decisions and enhancing the overall performance of the VRS.

- Monitoring Late Sitting Duties: The system provides real-time insights into daily late sitting duties, allowing for proactive management and improved accountability within the team.
- Simplified Report Generation: The VRS
 Dashboard enhances transparency and accessibility
 of critical information, making it easier for users to
 generate reports that support informed
 decision-making.



Quality Related Incident System (QRIS)

On May 2, 2024, the Quality Related Incident System dashboard was launched, which is a vital tool in comprehensive and real-time assessment of the quality management processes. This dashboard plays a pivotal role in enhancing the quality and safety practices across the organization.

Key features of the QRIS Dashboard include:

- Essential KPIs Tracking: The dashboard monitors critical metrics such as the total number of Quality Related Incidents (QRIs) raised, investigation completion rates, and incidents categorized by location and department, providing a clear view of quality performance.
- Detailed Incident Analysis: Users can explore detailed analysis of each incident, including the nature of the issue, equipment involved, and the status of recommendations, enabling stakeholders to make informed decisions swiftly.
- Monitoring QRIS Request Status: The dashboard allows real-time tracking of QRIS requests, helping teams identify trends and underlying issues, which fosters proactive management.
- Transparency and Accountability: By enhancing the visibility of quality-related incidents, the dashboard promotes a culture of accountability and supports continuous improvement initiatives.

Overall, the QRIS dashboard empowers PARCO to maintain high standards in incident management, ensuring a safer and more efficient operational environment.



Hazard Incident Reporting Analysis (HIRA)

On June 11, 2024, Phase II of the HIRA Dashboard was launched through collaboration between the Digitalization Department and Corporate HSE. This revamped system transforms the existing hazard analysis process into a dynamic, live dashboard that pulls real-time data directly from the source.

Key features of the HIRA Dashboard include:

- **Real-Time Data Access:** The dashboard provides instantaneous updates, ensuring that safety information is updated and actionable, which is essential for effective hazard management.
- Enhanced Details by Station: Users can now access detailed insights tailored to each station, allowing for more localized and relevant hazard analysis.
- **New KPI Metrics:** The introduction of new key performance indicators enriches the data available for monitoring safety performance, helping teams identify areas for improvement.
- Streamlined Hazard Analysis: By reducing redundant procedures and simplifying workflows, the dashboard enhances efficiency in the hazard analysis process, enabling quicker responses to potential risks.

This upgrade marks a significant step forward in our commitment to workplace safety and operational excellence, empowering teams with the tools they need to proactively manage hazards.

Operator Excellence Program Portal

The WOTS-3 Team has introduced a new online Operator Excellence Portal, a key development in Plant Operator Excellence Plan, initially envisioned by the Telecom/SCADA Team. This initiative aims to enhance the skills, efficiency, and qualifications of our plant operators, focusing on growth in three critical areas to navigate the complexities of multigrade operations.



- Control System Proficiency: Ensuring operators are well-versed in using our advanced control systems.
- Adherence to SOPs: Promoting strict adherence to SOPs for safe and efficient operations.
- · Robust Operator Assessments: Implementing thorough assessments to gauge and improve operator skills.

The portal, a one-stop training platform, features:

- o **Training Videos**: Covering all aspects of plant operations in the native language for better understanding and clarity.
- o Operator Manuals and Handouts: Comprehensive resources to support operators in their daily tasks.
- o **Scenario-based Training**: Focusing on MOGAS Operations, operators will learn to handle data loss or system failures effectively, ensuring seamless data switching and preventing blackouts.
- o HMI and SCADA System Awareness: Enhancing understanding of HMI and SCADA capabilities.



Post Go-Live Facilitation Sessions by Supply Chain

The Supply Chain Division, including CHQ, MCR, PPGL and the Stations, successfully launched Supply Chain Modules MM and SAP ARIBA with minimal issues during implementation. The Supply Chain team provided extensive support to users organization-wide, both before and after the implementation phase. This success can be attributed to the collective efforts of the Supply Chain Division, Central Projects, IT Teams, and the leadership's guidance and support throughout the process.

As the organization transitions into the post Go-Live phase, the Supply Chain team is actively addressing emerging challenges through collaboration with stakeholders. To provide immediate solutions, they organized sessions at various sites to resolve SAP ARIBA and SAP S/4 HANA issues.
